Artists must be a 2014 ArtWorks member to be eligible to participate. Membership applications can be found at http://www.artworksinc.org. Click on Join Now to sign up online or download a membership pdf to mail in.

Entered pieces must be original artwork. Art fabricated from published pattern/directional craft books/pamphlets, green-ware kits, and videos, slide, or CD presentations are not permitted. Exhibit organizers reserve the right to determine appropriate works, and may disqualify works from entry into the exhibition. Please check presentation guidelines below for acceptable sizes.

ALL ART MUST BE LESS THAN TWO YEARS OLD AND NOT EXHIBITED IN ANY OTHER JURIED EVENT OR VENUE.

AWARDS and CATEGORIES:

One best of show and several awards will be presented during the awards reception.

PROFESSIONAL ARTISTS: Includes college-level students and persons with significant art training, and those who teach art in any medium.

AMATEUR ARTISTS: All amateur entries will be combined into one division and one Best Amateur Award will be presented.

PRESENTATION GUIDELINES:

All work must be presented in a professional manner. Works intended for hanging must be prepared with properly-sized eyelets and wire. Plexiglas is strongly recommended for works larger than 24 inches. Maximum size for 2D work is 36" horizontal and 72" vertical. No saw-tooth hangers accepted – wired only. 3D work must be stable, also not larger than 36" horizontal and 72" vertical, and not weighing more than 100 lbs. All work must be ready for presentation.

LIABILITY:

Participating artists agree to hold harmless ArtWorks, Exhibition Chair, Exhibition Committee, and owners of exhibition venue for any such loss, theft, or damage that may occur while artwork is on display. Participating artists agree to grant permission to ArtWorks to photograph or video installed artwork for advertising purposes. **The Committee retains the final decision on acceptable artwork.**

SALES:

When artwork is sold during the exhibition, all sales are made through the Ellis Walker Gallery, 1945 Scottsville Road, Bowling Green. The Gallery will retain 30% of the sales price to cover overhead. The artists will be issued a check from ArtWorks, 70% of the sales price, 2-4 weeks after the closing date of the exhibition. The artist is responsible for paying taxes on earnings.

DEADLINE FOR ENTRY FORM/FEE/ARTWORK:

Bring entry form, \$20 entry fee (check payable to ArtWorks) and artwork (2 pieces maximum – fee includes both pieces) Thursday, May 1, 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. to the ARTWORKS SPACE, 1945 Scottsville Road.

LATE ENTRY FORMS, FEES, ARTWORK, OR CHANGE OF SUBMITTED WORK WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

AGREEMENT

Work will be on exhibit Friday, May 9 through Friday, June 6 during the scheduled hours, tba. All unsold work must be picked up on Saturday, June 7 between 3-5 p.m.
